

Preface

Spanish, Portuguese, French, & Italian (at the same time) exemplifies the first of 3 Core Principles of language learning: Language is a matrix.

The nature of all languages is such that you can make virtually unlimited possibilties - statements, questions - by mixing and matching words within the template of that language.

In fact, when speaking a language, you're always just mixing and matching words.

This book presents the 4 main Romance languages in a matrix format, so you can create your own sentences at will, making language learning more of a do-it-yourself process.

It is the goal of The Language Matrix (langmatrix.com) to make people better language learners - like teaching you to fish rather than giving you fish.

Simply put: the grammar patterns of a language are like the lines of a coloring book, and vocabulary is the color. With that in mind, your goal in becoming conversational in the language is to converse! The same way you learn to ride a bike by getting on the bike and riding.

Let Spanish, Portuguese, French, & Italian (at the same time) help you get on the bike by beginning to think, write, and speak in the language(s) of your choice right away.
